Our refined military-style training includes two contractor-owned, contractor-operated turn-key flight school campuses. Since 2006, our Pueblo, Colorado operation has been dedicated to screening and training all Air Force aviation candidates as well as U.S. Marine Corps unmanned aircraft candidates. Our Raton, New Mexico flight school is approved by the FAA under Part 141 and accepts international and domestic customers. The Raton campus is organized for a broad range of basic and advanced fixed-wing, rotary-wing and unmanned flight training students. Doss re-entered rotary-wing training in 2014 with advanced training to U.S. Army aviators in the AH-64D Apache, UH-60L/M Blackhawk and CH-47F Chinook at Ft Rucker, Alabama. Additionally, Doss provides special mission training, including search and rescue, firefighting, and hoisting, to Taiwanese aircrews in the UH-60M. Doss Aviation has experience maintaining a wide variety of general aviation/commercial-derivative military aircraft including Bell, Cessna, Cirrus, deHavilland, Diamond and Piper manufactured aircraft. We also provide aviation fuels, wash, and Transient Alert services at several US and overseas locations.
