

Best Preparation for Rigors of IFT

What is Pre-IFT?

One-week course taught by Doss' IFT Instructor Pilots to:

- Learn how to succeed in the rigorous flight training approach used at IFT and Undergraduate Flight Training.
- Build flight time in IFT's unique reverse-cockpit DA-20 aircraft.
- Become familiar with the IFT campus and operation.

What you will learn?

Students learn the following to better prepare them for what is expected of them at IFT and Undergraduate Flight Training:

- Basic academics and flying techniques to fly safely.
- How to fly the reverse-cockpit DA-20: low-wing, throttle in left-hand / stick control in right-hand.
- Familiarization to the military-style training approach (e.g., Stand-up, bold face memorization, VFR arrival/departure procedures, step-desk briefing).
- End of course report card: Understand your weaknesses and strengths as you enter IFT.

Where is this taught?

The Pre-IFT Program is taught at Doss Aviation's Flight Training Center at Raton, New Mexico and includes a DA-20 flight to the IFT campus in Pueblo, Colorado for IFT orientation and lunch.

Who should attend?

Doss Aviation's Pre-IFT Program is a rigorous military-style immersion flight training program specifically designed to prepare aspiring Air Force aviators. Those best suited for this program include:

- AF cadets who want to build flight time for the pilot selection board and experience what it takes to be an Air Force aviator.
- AF officers waiting to attend IFT.
- AF cadets or officers exempt from IFT but want to experience military flight training rigors before attending Undergraduate Flight Training.
